Foundation Europejskie Centrum Watsu im Harolda Dulla in Dobrociez, Poland, realizing its mission and goals wish to provide opportunity for spreading aquatic therapy education across the globe and supporting those in need, offer **Humanitarian Tickets** for 5th International Watsu Conference.

The Humanitarian Ticket is reserved strictly for individuals residing in and representing organizations based in nations facing severe economic challenges or active armed conflicts.

To eliminate ambiguity, eligibility is determined strictly by the following international databases:

1. **Least Developed Countries (LDCs):** Nations officially classified under the current UN List of Least Developed Countries: <https://www.oecd.org/en/topics/sub-issues/oda-eligibility-and-conditions/dac-list-of-oda-recipients.html#note-on-letters>
2. **Conflict-Affected Situations:** Nations classified explicitly under the active "**Conflict**" category of the World Bank List of Fragile and Conflict-Affected Situations: <https://thedocs.worldbank.org/en/doc/d2e218e68a25ba7a31147a7455f35cae-0090082026/original/A1-FY27-FCV-List.pdf>

Verification Process:

- **Institutional Email:** Applicants must register using an official domain email address (e.g., .edu, .org, or specific NGO/institutional extensions).
- **Proof of Residency:** If an institutional email is unavailable, a scanned document confirming current residency or official employment in an eligible country must be submitted prior to registration.
- **Payment Check:** The country of issuance for the credit/debit card used for payment must match the declared eligible country.

The Organizer reserves the right to reject applications or cancel tickets if the attendee's status cannot be verified.
